

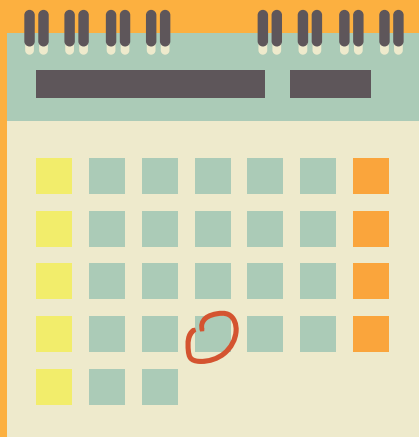

Appeals - Step by Step



1 Knowing when you can appeal

You can only appeal a decision made by the Student Progress Panel, this is not the same as a grade awarded by your lecturer. You will be notified by email when the Student Progress Panel has met and then have 28 days to submit an appeal.

2 Having your first meeting

or just come in to the office, opposite the main lecture theatre.



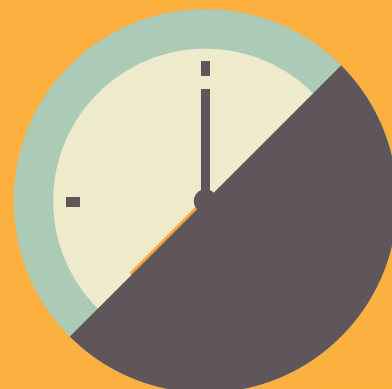
3 Taking the appeal forward

We will explain and guide you through the process of the appeal, provide the forms and help you fill them out.

4 Submitting & awaiting reply

We will help you with submission and will explain the possible outcomes and how you can take it further if it is unsuccessful.
